



IOSH Working Safely

Course Overview

The course is designed to train employees to make sure that their actions in the workplace contribute to health and safety, and that they clearly understand their health and safety responsibilities.

Course Objectives

- Understand the need to work safely
- Won't put others at risk
- Can explain the consequences to both the individual and their organisation if they fail to work safely
- Can define the terms 'hazard', 'risk' and 'risk controls'
- Can explain the importance of risk assessment
- Can give examples of risk assessment from everyday life
- Appreciate the role of workplace precautions
- Can use appropriate workplace precautions
- Can describe a health and safety management system
- Can identify lines of communication with respect to health and safety in their place of work
- Can identify safety signs and signals
- Are aware of emergency and accident plans and procedures in their place of work
- Know how to report accidents, incidents and near misses, and who to report them to
- Are aware of how industry affects the environment, and can list ways in which individuals and organisations can minimise pollution and waste
